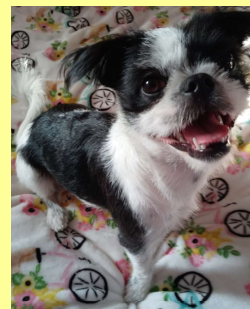

## WHO WE ARE

The Andrew Norman Foundation (the "Foundation") strives to help young adults in or coming out of foster care, to meet their educational and personal needs. The Los Angeles Foster Care System currently houses 31,927 children. Many of them "age out" which means that at 18, they leave their foster home without having been adopted and go out into the world alone. Assembly Bill 12 now allows youth to stay in foster care until age 21, if they so choose. There are 3,869 youth who have recently aged out of the system and many of these kids ultimately become homeless because of their inability to pay for their education, housing, food, etc.

The Foundation works directly with the Los Angeles Dept. of Child Services to determine the immediate needs for youth who have aged out of the system and have no other support. Your donation would help meet these financial needs by providing scholarships for colleges or trade schools. It is our goal that no young adult coming out of foster care miss out on educational opportunities because of lack of funds.

## Lemon Pound Cake Cookies

Ingredients:

¾ cup white sugar

2/3 cup salted sweet cream butter, softened

2 cups all-purpose flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

2 eggs

2 teaspoons lemon extract

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F

Cream sugar and butter together in a bowl using an electric mixer until light and fluffy.

Whisk flour and baking powder together in a separate bowl; gradually beat into creamed butter mixture until just combined. Beat eggs, one at a time, into butter-flour mixture until dough is thoroughly mixed; stir in lemon extract. Drop small scoops of dough onto a baking sheet.



Bake in the preheated oven until cookies spring back when touched, 10 to 12 minutes. Add a lemon glaze for more flavor if you like.
